

Policy for Camp Sites

General Camping Rules:

- All camping will be on a first come first serve basis
- One camping unit per site with the exception of one tent for dependent children under the age of eighteen
- A campsite is considered occupied when the camping fees have been paid and a vehicle or camping unit is on site.
- All campers must register in one hour after arrival
- All campers are allowed to camp for a maximum of a two week period.
- If occupying an electrical site you must pay the electrical fee whether or not using electricity

Season Pass Holders:

- Must pay electrical fee
- Season pass is specific to the individual and camper
- Must abide by all general camping rules
- The camping unit is allowed for only 14 out a 21 days in any park

Two Week Rule:

- Camping is allowed 14 out of 21 days
- After 14 days all campers must leave the park for a minimum of seven days
- After Labor Day until the end of the camping season, the 14 day rule still applies but campers will be allowed to stay in the park, while moving to a different location in the park. (Specifics must be designated by the ranger.)

Administrative Exemptions:

- The park ranger may give and administrative exemption for locations for the following reasons: Natural Disasters, ADA Concerns, Family Emergencies, or special events.
